The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) toward the cost of Natural Gas Infrastructure and Efficiency Improvement Project. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries as defined in Section 5 of the bidding documents.
2. The Gas Transmission Company Limited (GTCL) ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Installation of 36" OD high pressure natural gas pipeline by Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) method across the river Feni, Mohuri, Kalidas and Dakatia on Design, Procurement, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning on Turn-key basis.

(b) Qualification Criteria for Bidders:

- Technical Experience: Participation in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last 05 (five) years and that is similar to the proposed contract, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds US\$ 5.50 million. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6 (Employer's Requirements).
 - Experience in Key Activities: The Bidder should demonstrate a minimum experience on Design, Procurement, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of high pressure natural gas transmission pipeline across one river of 300 meter X 30 inch OD pipe or above by HDD method on Turn-key basis within last 05 (five) years.
 - Size of Operation (Average Annual Turnover): The Bidder shall have minimum average annual turnover of US\$12.00 million over the last 05 (five) years.
3. International competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: Two-Envelope procedure and is open to all bidders from eligible countries as described in Section 5 of the Bidding document.
